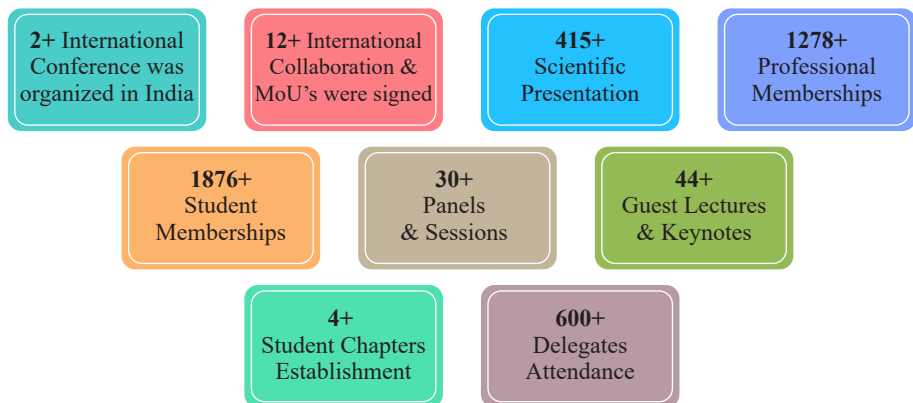
CEO's MESSAGE

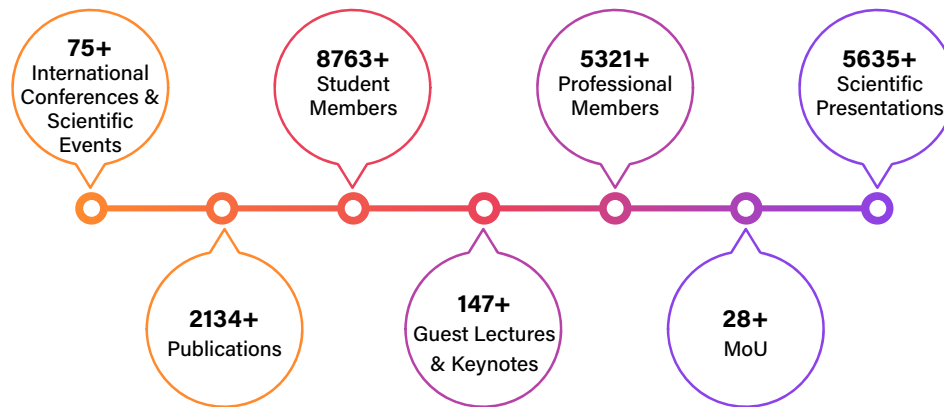

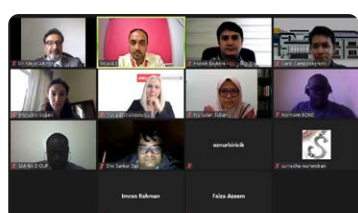
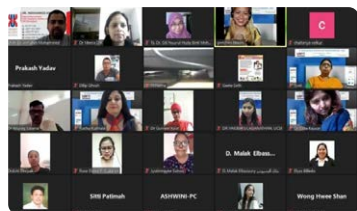
03rd Indo-Oncology Summit

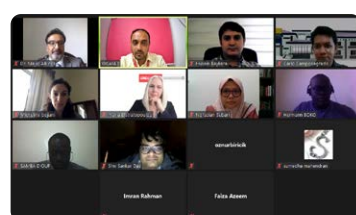

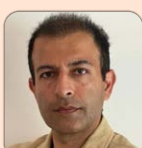
